ePAY View and pay your bill online!

ePay is the official billing and payment system for actively-enrolled students at NCSU. Your billing statements will be available online only. You will receive a notice in your University e-mail account that provides a link to view your account charges and payment due amounts. You will login to your ePay account with your unity ID and password. This ensures that you are the only person who has access to your billing information online. You may choose to pay online by deducting the payment from a checking or savings account. You may also set up an authorized payer, such as a parent, to pay electronically on your behalf. To make payments by U.S. mail or in-person at the University Cashier's Office or drop box location, print the PDF copy of your electronic bill to enclose with your check or money order.
